Embrace the English-rose brand of beauty by working a pink flush on cheeks. Michael Brown from Lancôme has us blushing.

1 "Colours are important. If you want to slim your face, go brown or bronzy shades. If it's a glow-enhancing effect you want, go a soft pink. Apricots and peaches suit everyone and are a safe bet."

2 "Always sweep the brush downwards from the hairline, just where the ear starts, and continue on a diagonal towards the mouth, under the cheekbone. Brushing upwards makes for an unnatural effect, whereas my technique lifts the cheekbones and looks clean."

3 "Powers are the easiest and give a gorgeous result—they glide across skin when used over foundation. Creams are great for dry skin as they make it look plumper, while tints are perfect for first-timers or those who want that kissed look and not full-on colour."
